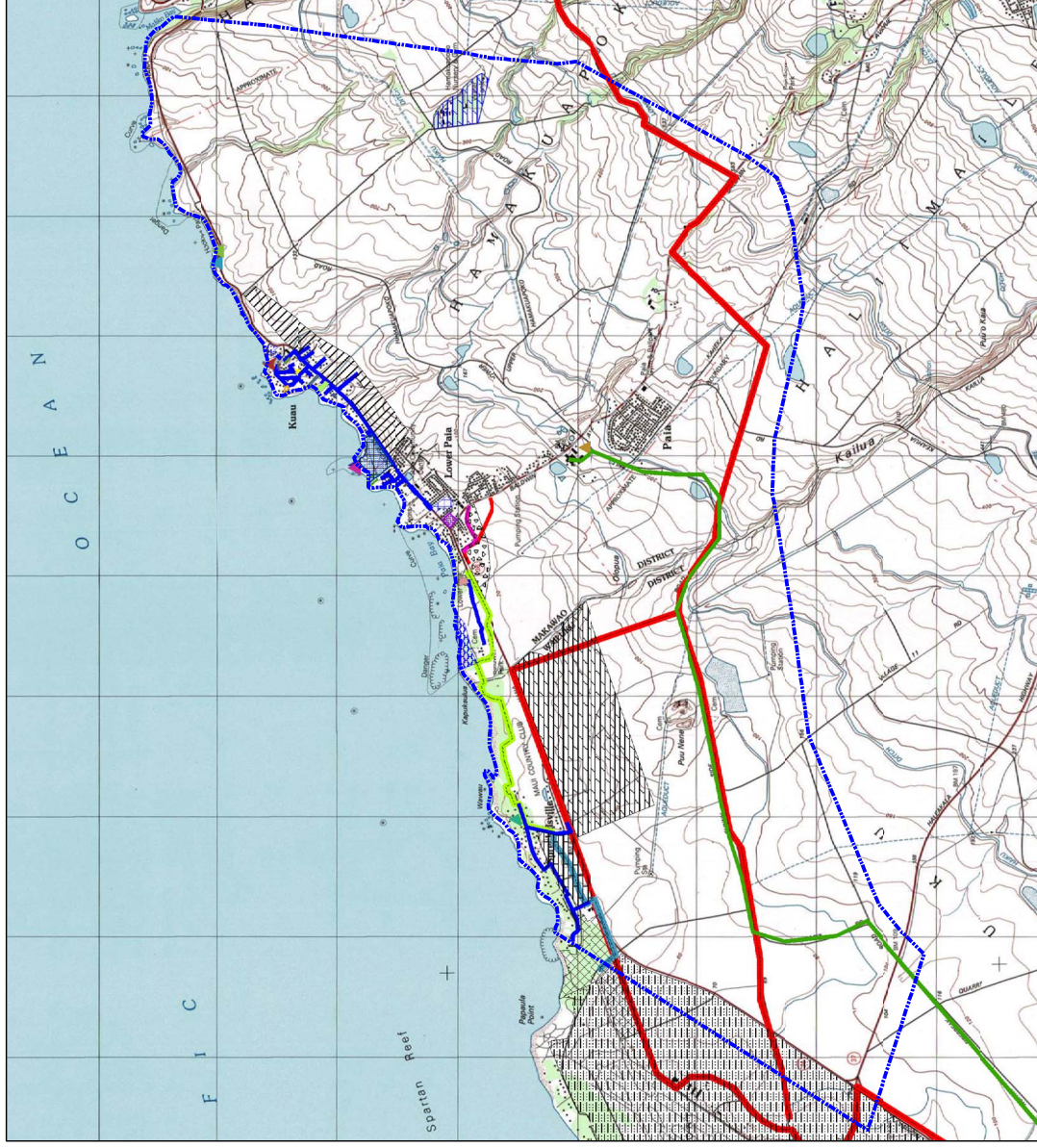
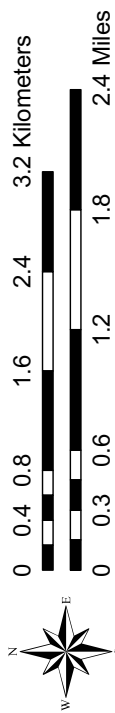
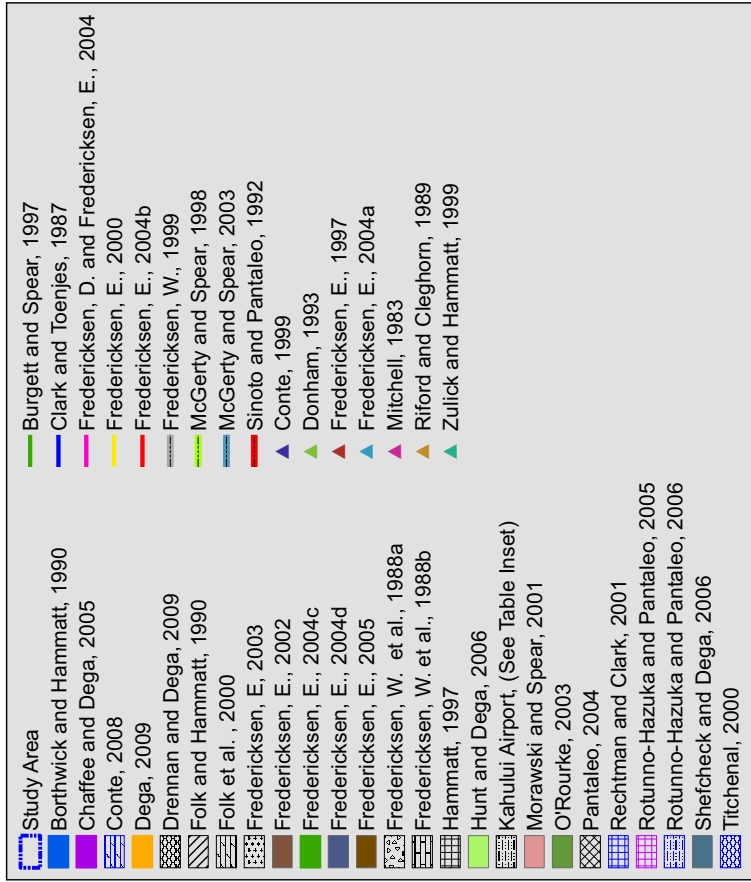

	1991	Lands north of the existing Kahului Airport bound by Alahau Street, Kaliaimui Drainage Channel, Kahului Airport Runway 5-23.

Mitchell	1983	Documentation: Identification of seven localities along the cliff face where human remains were exposed due to wind and sea erosion. It is unknown if the remains were collected at the time of documentation.
Bowen	1968	Field notes: Excavation of 3 one-meter units identifying four distinct strata with cultural layers recorded in Strata 2 and 3. Three <i>in situ</i> burials identified in two of three test units.
McQuagge and Mish	1989	Maini Community College Student Report: Under the direction of Demaris Fredericksen, Ph.D. two students recovered the remains of three individuals due to erosion and exposure while two were left <i>in situ</i> as they were not in immediate danger.
Conte	1999	SHIPD In House Report: Partial recovery of at least five individuals from the cliff face.
