

## PROPOSED ALIGNMENTS WITH MAJOR HISTORIC PRESERVATION CONSTRAINTS

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A total of five proposed alignment options were evaluated as having major constraints.

### Option A – Hana Highway Widening

- Total of four known burial site or cemeteries were identified within the corridor.
- At total of five known pre-contact cultural deposits were identified within the corridor.
- A total of seven isolated fire pit/hearth features were identified within the corridor.
- Historic buildings line the current section of Hana Highway as it passes through Paia town thus presenting a significant amount of HABS/HAER documentation.
- Known pre-contact and historic era cemeteries and isolated burials, as well as, cultural material deposits present a high potential for encountering additional significant subsurface archaeological findings.

### Option B – Alawai Road to Ho'okipa

- One known pre-contact burial site identified within the corridor.
- Known pre-contact presents a high potential for encountering additional significant subsurface archaeological findings.

### Option E – Nonohe Road to Ho'okipa

- One known pre-contact burial site identified within the corridor.
- Known pre-contact presents a high potential for encountering additional significant subsurface archaeological findings.

### Option M – Northshore Heritage Loop: Makai Variant

- Passes through the Old Maui High School parcel currently being evaluated for placement on the State and National Register of Historic Places.
- Historic buildings and structures associated with the Old Maui High School presents a significant amount of HABS/HAER documentation.
- Passes through six former camp/village locations presenting a medium to high potential for encountering significant subsurface historic era deposits.
- Passes through 11 historically known plantation infrastructure features thus adding to the high potential for additional HAER documentation

### Option N – Northshore Heritage Loop: Holomua Road Variant

- Directly adjacent to the Old Maui High School parcel currently being evaluated for placement on the State and National Register of Historic Places.
- Historic buildings and structures associated with the Old Maui High School presents a significant amount of HABS/HAER documentation.
- Passes through four former camp/village locations presenting a medium to high potential for encountering significant subsurface historic era deposits.
- Passes through 13 historically known plantation infrastructure features thus adding to the high potential for additional HAER documentation.

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### Option C – 1972 Environmental Assessment

- Low to Medium potential in all evaluation categories.
- No known pre-contact or historic era historic properties within the evaluation corridor.
- One historically known plantation infrastructure feature presenting the potential for only nominal HAER documentation.

### Option G – Field 609 – Pa'ia Post Office – Ho'okipa (A&B Proposed Alignment)

- Low and Low to Medium potential in all evaluation categories.
- No known pre-contact or historic era historic properties within the evaluation corridor.
- Passes through five historically known plantation infrastructure features presenting the potential for only nominal HAER documentation.
- Passes through one former camp/village locations presenting low to medium potential for encountering significant subsurface historic era deposits.
